God's Promise

The great God who made heaven and earth works according to uniform "laws" or phenomena. He always takes the same path through His universe. You can always predict where God will be and always know how it is with God. That's why the Word of God stands secure. When you meet certain conditions, you can always be sure that there will be certain results because God is always taking that path through His Bible, always going by the same road through the Scriptures – always! God never backtracks or detours, but always goes the same way all the time.

When God makes a promise, God keeps that promise. If the promise is over here and you're over there, it will be a dead promise, but if you come over to where it is, it will be a live promise. If God makes a promise and puts conditions on it, and you don't meet the conditions but plead the promise, nothing will happen. You can pray for a lifetime and nothing will happen. But if you meet the conditions and go where God is, you'll find God right there all the time. That's the way it works! That's why you can have faith in God and know, absolutely, that God is there.
